Classes

Class 1—Nursery Agility 2 Rounds	Class 2—Nursery Steeplechase 2 Rounds

Agility

The course may consist of jumps, tunnels, weaves and contact equipment—2x runs, best time counts

Steeplechase

A flowing course consisting of jumps and tunnels—2x runs, best time counts

Nursery

For dogs and handlers that have never competed before (except club matches, dogs who have won this class will automatically be entered in Starters). Classes will not include weaves or the seesaw. Dog walk & A frame will be set to lower height. Silent toys may be carried. Dogs may jump on height lower than their normal height.

Starter

For dogs and handlers that compete at Kennel club grades 1&2 or their equivalent at unaffiliated shows i.e. Elementary or starters. Or for dogs that have won a class at a Club Match. Classes will not include weaves.

Open

For dogs and handlers that compete at Kennel Club grade 3 and above, or their equivalent at unaffiliated shows i.e. Novice, senior, advanced. This class will have weaves

INFORMATION/RULES

- Club match is to be held at Bold Heath Equestrian Centre.
- Tail Waggers club match is a series of 4-5 matches open to club members only. Points will be placed down to 10th place. The points will be accumulated over the year with the highest scoring dogs in each class being awarded the title of Tail Waggers Champion.
- All competing dogs must be over 15 months of age and be able to safely negotiate all obstacles.
- No leads, titbits or bumbags allowed in the ring. Silent toys may be carried in the Nursery class and other classes if running NFC.
- The course time for each class will be 60 seconds, if you exceed this time a whistle will be blown and you will be asked to leave the ring.
- You will get two runs at each course, each class will go through each height before you have your second go.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.
- All courses should be walked at the beginning of the class.
- Dogs to wear a flat collar with no tags when competing. No harsh handling allowed.
- Please wait for the scribe to start you, failing to do so may result in elimination.
- All heights will be combined for awards.
- Heights: Large—for dogs 17" & over at the withers—jump height 24". Medium—for dogs 16 " & under at the withers—jump height 17.75". Small—for dogs 14" & under at the withers—jump height 13.75". Micro—for dogs 12" & under at the withers—jump height 9".
- Refusals will not be marked in the Nursery class.
- The aim of the club match is to test what you have learnt and for you and your dog to have fun, no matter how wrong it all goes. Have fun and enjoy yourself!

Rosettes awarded to 20%. Clear round rosettes for all unplaced clears.
Prizes for 1st place (for classes with more that 6 dogs)
